### A Safe Return

Welcome Back M.O.C.I. members! The Fall 2020 semester is in full swing. Whether you're with us in person or virtually this semester, the university and M.O.C.I. want

to make sure you're

staying well, studious, and safe. Here are some helpful precautions to take:

- •Maintain distance of at least 6 feet between yourself and others to limit the chance of breathing any droplets that contain COVID-19.
  - •Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing or sneezing and throw the tissue away after use. If a tissue isn't available, cough or sneeze into your elbow or sleeve, not your hands
- ·Wear a face covering in public to provide a barrier to COVID-19 transmission.
- •Wash your hands frequently following CDC guidelines to kill viruses on your hands.
- Avoid touching your face. Your hands touch many surfaces and can pick up viruses. Touching your face provides a route through which the virus can infect you.
